Cumberland County GOP Elects

Lou Capozzi as New Chair

(Hampden Township PA): Last night, 149 members of the Cumberland County Republican Committee held a reorganization meeting at the Good Hope Fire Hall. After presentations from all nominated candidates and extensive vetting by the committee, Capozzi received the majority of votes cast and became the county party's new chairman.

Mr. Capozzi has served as a Republican Committeeman has lived in South Middleton Township for almost twenty years and been a committeeman since 2010. His leadership in Republican politics began in 1987 when he founded and chaired Philadelphia's Center City Young Republicans. Lou received his Juris Doctorate from Villanova Law School in 1986; he is the President and CEO of Capozzi Adler, P.C. He and his wife, Shelley, have been married for almost twenty years.
